Birds of Louth Raises Over £2,200 for The Brain Tumour Charity

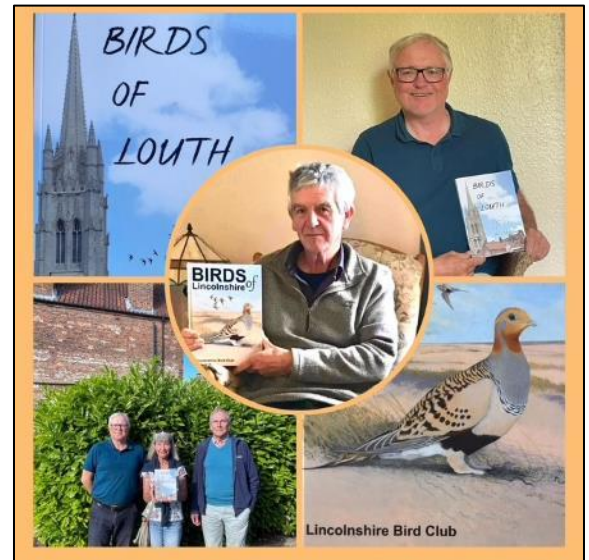
Phil Espin writes:

I'm delighted to share that all profits from the sale of *Birds of Louth*, along with fees from talks I've given this year, have been donated to The Brain Tumour Charity in memory of former Lincolnshire County Recorder, John Clarkson. Thanks to the generosity and support of everyone who bought a copy or helped to sell the book – especially members of the Lincolnshire Bird Club – we have raised a fantastic total of £2,206.

John was born and raised in Louth and had a lifelong love for the town and its birdlife. He published the original edition of *Birds of Louth* in 2007 and was keen to produce a new edition that would showcase not only his own photographs but also those of his friends. After we co-wrote *Birds of Lincolnshire* with Colin Casey and Phil Hyde in 2021, John asked me to write a new text for the Louth book. We had only just begun working on it when, in August 2022, he was diagnosed with a brain tumour. Sadly, John passed away the following year, in September 2023. Completing the book became his final wish.

With the support of his wife Nicky and brother-in-law Geoff Mullett, we were able to finish the project. We are proud that the book now stands as a lasting legacy to John and his contribution to birding in Lincolnshire.

Of the original 510 copies printed, fewer than 40 remain. The Lincolnshire Bird Club has now sold out of its allocation, so the book is no longer available online. However, a limited number of copies can still be found



through Nicky Clarkson, who can be contacted via email at nickymclarkson@gmail.com. The book is also available at Haith's new retail store in Louth, the Louth Cheese Shop on Eastgate, and St James's Church.

If you missed my talk on *Birds of Louth*, your final opportunity to hear it will be at the Grimsby RSPB Members Group on Monday 17th November. There may still be a few copies of the book available on the night, priced at £12.

Thank you once again to everyone who helped support this project and contributed to keeping John's memory alive.

AviList – uniting all of the world's bird species

AviList was published on June 11th 2025 after 4 years of work by experts in taxonomy, nomenclature, and bioinformatics and included researchers from the Cornell Lab of Ornithology, American Ornithological Society, BirdLife International, International Ornithologists' Union, and Avibase.



It is a brand-new, complete global checklist of species and taxonomy. Containing 11,131 species, 19,879 subspecies, 2,376 genera, 252 families and 46 orders, it brings together the latest global thinking on what constitutes a species and shakes up our understanding of the avian world. It provides the most current and authoritative taxonomy of birds around the world.

Although this news is likely to go down like a lead balloon with some/many in the birding community, it should at least provide a unified reference to bird taxonomy. LBC agreed to follow the British Ornithologists Union (BOU) who committed to follow IOC taxonomy from January 2017 (IOC will soon be using AviList).

At the time of writing (22nd June) it has not been announced when BOU will take the decision to update the British list in accordance with AviList. No immediate switch to AviList is envisaged by LBC but we intend to follow BOU/BBRC for our annual reports as and when they commit to this new taxonomy.

In terms of practical recording, we intend to maintain Lincolnshire records of all races that are split and lumped, ready for the time when these decisions are reversed! We strongly encourage all Lincolnshire birders to do the same.

A Successful Year for Louth's Peregrine Falcons

Louth's resident peregrine falcons have enjoyed a strong breeding season in 2025, with three chicks successfully hatched, ringed, and fledged from the church tower.

The chicks were ringed on 2nd June with distinctive East Midlands orange leg rings, useful for identification by photographers and birdwatchers with telescopes. The rings were recorded as XTT, XVT, and XXT. Initial assessments suggested the brood included one female, one male, and one chick of unknown sex. DNA testing will confirm their sexes later this year, with results expected in December.

All three juveniles fledged around/from 18th June. That evening, two of the youngsters were observed roosting back in the nest, and early the next morning, an adult was seen flying to a gargoyle on the church's north side, where one of the juveniles was already perched. Footage from the site suggests food was delivered and left nearby, although there were no clear signs of the birds flying out to collect it.

A few days later, on 22nd June, ringed chick XXT was found grounded on the grass on the church's north side. It was carefully retrieved and returned to the tower, loudly demanding food as it went.

XVT took flight on 23rd June, eventually ending up on the roof of a garage at 82 Westgate, where it likely spent a damp and hungry night. Still stranded the following day, the chick found itself trapped by the high walls at each end of the roof, making it difficult to take off. Around 10:45am, it managed to make a short flight, landing by the church's west door. Once again, it was safely returned to the tower, this time by Verger Dale.

Despite a few minor adventures, all three young peregrines made it through their first critical weeks, and their story highlights the continued success of this iconic urban breeding pair. It's been a rewarding and positive year for the Louth peregrines, and for all those who have followed their progress.

Overall, a great year, thanks to Geoff Mullet and all at St James's for all the effort put in during the breeding season 2025...

Peregrine Falcons Thrive at St Wulfram's in a Landmark 2025 Season

After years of mixed fortunes, the 2025 breeding season has been a true success story for the peregrine falcons at St Wulfram's Church, Grantham. This year saw three healthy chicks raised, ringed, and fledged – marking a high point in the church's long-running efforts to support these magnificent birds of prey.

The chicks were ringed on 28th May and early indications suggest all three are females, a promising sign for the species' continued recovery. Just days later, by 31st May, the young birds were already exploring beyond the confines of the nest tray, becoming increasingly adventurous and sometimes disappearing from view on the church's popular webcam.

As June progressed, the chicks quickly lost their fluffy down and began to take on the sleeker, more streamlined look of juvenile peregrines. By mid-June, they had taken their first flights, with all three successfully fledging around the 16th. A striking photograph taken on 20th June captured the trio perched confidently on the ledges of St Wulfram's tower – a symbol of the season's success.

The wider community embraced the falcons this year, with Father Stuart Cradock speaking on BBC Radio Lincolnshire and inviting the public to help name the young birds. Their story even made it onto the BBC News website, reflecting growing interest in urban wildlife and the role churches like St Wulfram's play in its protection.

This success would not have been possible without the dedication of a small but passionate team. Special thanks go to Alan Ball, Bob Sheppard, and Elaine Chambers, whose tireless efforts have helped ensure the falcons continue to thrive above the rooftops of Grantham.

With three strong young peregrines taking to the skies, 2025 will be remembered as a breakthrough year, and one that bodes well for the future of this iconic species at St Wulfram's. The photograph below is of the Grantham three by Gavin Turner!

Pallas's Warbler-A Short History by Pete Locking

For many years, the Pallas's Warbler was high on my must-see list. But after every notification, I would either arrive too late or simply fail to see one. That was until 17th October 2020, when I finally caught up with my first — showing quite well, flitting about in a sycamore at Sea View Farm, Saltfleet.

Another brief sighting followed, acting on a WhatsApp message from Chris Atkin — again in Saltfleet — with some Goldcrests just at dusk on 25th October 2023.

This brings me to my best-ever encounter with my favourite bird. At 13:47 on 3rd November 2024, Owen Beaumont passed on a post from an anonymous birder reporting a Pallas's Warbler at Donna Nook.

We stopped what we were doing, jumped in the car, and flew down — at an arguably irresponsible speed — to Stone Bridge car park. Jackie and I were the last members of the North Somercotes Mafia to arrive; Mark Brandon, Gill Butt, and Mark Johnson were even quicker off the mark and had already located the bird. The anonymous birder was still there with his mates from Notts, getting pats on the back for his quick thinking in posting it on Facebook.

We stayed for about an hour, our spirits lifted by watching this delightful long-distance migrant hovering in and out of a big willow, feeding on insects.

The Pallas's Warbler was first identified by Peter Simon Pallas in 1772 by the Ingoda River in Siberia — and he promptly named the bird after himself. The etiquette in bird naming usually involves someone else naming it after the discoverer, or giving it a different name altogether, but Pallas managed to get away with it by claiming he named all his discoveries in honour of his father!

Phylloscopus (meaning "leaf searcher") *proregulus* (meaning "like a Goldcrest") had a confused and slightly false start in Britain. A bird shot in Hartlepool in 1836 was identified as *Regulus modestus*, or "Dalmatian Regulus", a name given by John Gould (of Gouldian Finch fame, plus 23 other species) in 1837. This determination was accepted for many years.

However, in 1840 it was shown that Gould's bird had in fact been described many years earlier by Pallas. Then, in 1863, Robert Swinhoe (of Swinhoe's Storm Petrel and a dozen other species) identified the Hartlepool bird as a Yellow-browed Warbler – the first of that species to be recorded in the British Isles.

The first genuine Pallas's Warbler seen in Britain was in 1896, when one was shot (of course) in Norfolk. It wasn't until 1951 that a second turned up – on 19th October at Monk's House in Northumberland. The first Lincolnshire records were of two single birds caught simultaneously on 19th October 1968 at Anderby Creek and Gibraltar Point.

These days, bird ID – while still sometimes difficult – is made far easier thanks to full-colour field guides, internet photo libraries, and second opinions only a WhatsApp message away. It's easy to forget that in the 17th and 18th centuries, bird identification relied on letters, journals (not always in English), and sometimes years of correspondence. Engravings – in black and white, or occasionally hand-tinted – were often taken from taxidermied birds posed in glass cases. All things considered, the confusion described above is entirely forgivable.

For further reading on the current status of the Pallas's Warbler in Lincolnshire, consult the excellent *Birds of Lincolnshire*. If you don't yet have a copy, the club still has a few left!

Rare Collared Pratincole Draws Birders to Frampton Marsh

Frampton Marsh RSPB Reserve played host to a rare visitor in late June, when a Collared Pratincole was discovered by visiting birder Mathew Mellor on 22nd June 2025.

Initial reports surfaced on the Frampton RSPB WhatsApp group, suggesting that a Pratincole species had been sighted. The bird was eventually located from the Visitor Centre, where it was seen crouching low in vegetation and partially hidden. RSPB staff were able to confirm its identity as a Collared Pratincole.

The bird remained on site for several days, offering excellent views to many visiting birdwatchers. It was most often seen on the Marsh Farm grassland and regularly returned to roost in front of the reedbed hide. At the time of writing, it was last observed on 29th June, when it was seen flying purposefully south before disappearing into the distance.

This is only the sixth record for Lincolnshire, reinforcing the species' status as a rare vagrant in the county. The first was a bird shot at Branston Hall near Lincoln in 1827, followed by a 146-year gap until another appeared at Gibraltar Point in May 1973.

There were three further sightings between 1981 and 2011. On 11th July 1981, a bird was found at Donna Nook. Another brief visitor appeared at Frampton Marsh on 8th–9th August 2009, disappearing to the southeast on its first day, then reappearing the next day for three hours before departing north. This bird was noted to be missing several primaries in its left wing. The most recent, prior to this year's bird, was discovered during a breeding bird survey at Killingholme Marshes on 27th April 2011. That individual stayed until 7th May and was the only British record that year, frequenting pools amidst the industrial landscape of the Humber bank oil industry.

Nationally, the Collared Pratincole remains a genuine rarity. Between 1950 and 2018, just 77 records were accepted in Britain, with several more pending from 2019 and 2020. Averaging around one record per year, its appearance at Frampton this summer was a significant and exciting event for local and visiting birders alike.

Lincs Bird Club Website News

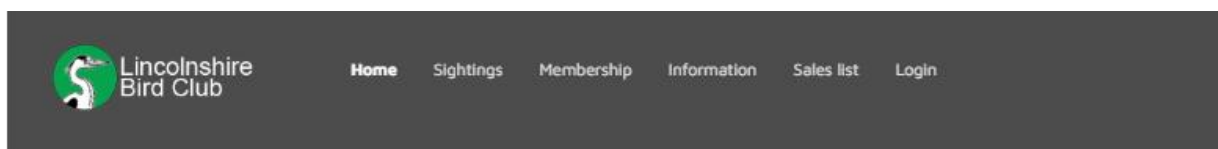

Knepp's White Storks Complete Epic Migration to Morocco and Back

White Storks born at the Knepp Castle Estate in West Sussex have made a remarkable return this spring, migrating thousands of miles to spend the winter in Morocco before flying back to nest at their birthplace.

At least six storks born at Knepp in 2024 have been confirmed back on site this year, with several returning to join the growing colony. One young female has even settled in the very same tree as her parents, according to White Stork Project Officer Laura Vaughan-Hirsch.

Knepp Castle Estate owner Isabella Tree noted the encouraging signs of wild interaction, saying the storks were “interacting with wild birds and bringing wild birds back with them as pairs.”

The White Stork Project, based at Knepp and releasing birds since 2016, has made steady progress toward re-establishing this iconic species in southern England. The first nesting attempt came in 2020, when two pairs nested and one successfully raised chicks. Since then, breeding success has steadily improved, with record numbers achieved in both 2022 and 2024.

This year is shaping up to be another strong one, with more than 12 chicks fledged by May and a further 40 expected in the coming weeks. While the long-term goal remains to establish a self-sustaining wild population, the project team acknowledges that it may take many more years before White Storks are firmly re-established in the Sussex landscape.

Knepp-bred storks are already turning up across the UK and beyond, with sightings reported from various parts of Europe and North Africa. Project staff aim to ring every chick, but with the colony growing rapidly, this is becoming an increasingly challenging task.

Looking ahead, similar reintroduction efforts are being considered in Cornwall and London. However, not all sites have remained within the scheme, a location in Surrey, once part of the wider White Stork Project, withdrew from the initiative in 2023.

Despite the challenges, the success of the Knepp storks is a powerful symbol of what rewilding can achieve, and a hopeful step toward restoring one of Britain's long-lost breeding birds.

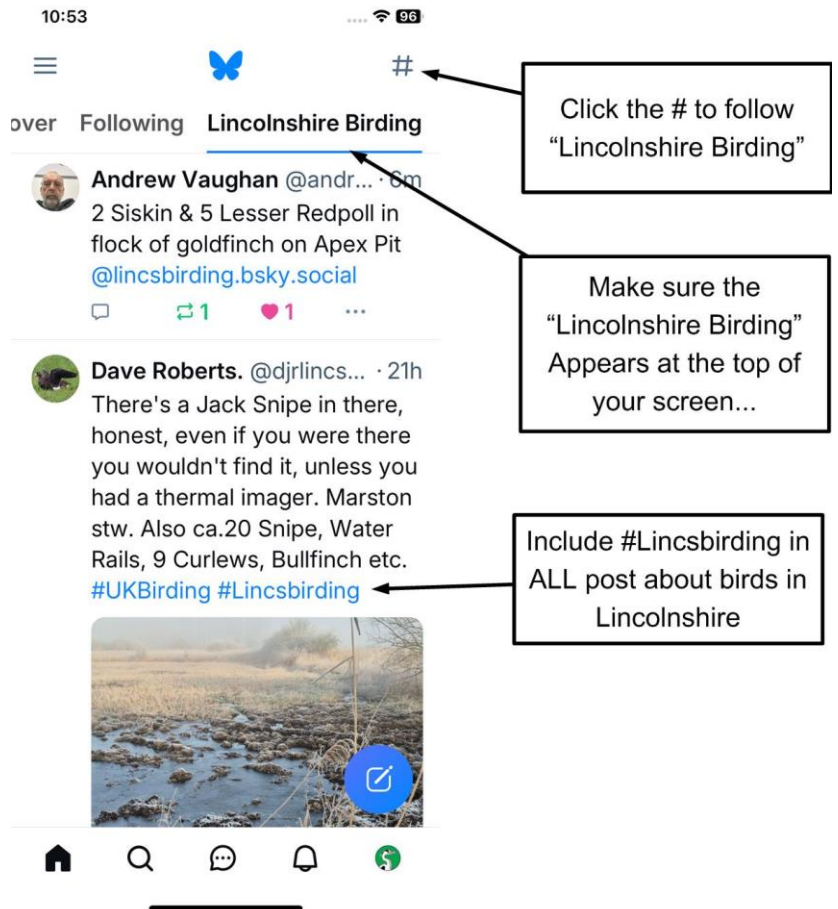
